


Chadbourn Elementary School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006








Item 9 Responses: Tobacco use on campus is $\underline{\text{NOT}}$ widespread among students who attend this school.




Item 20 Responses: Homework assignments consist of things that teachers cover in class with students.






