


Chadbourn Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006




Chadbourn Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Effective Instruction</u> December 15, 2006








Item 20 Responses: Homework assignments consist of things that teachers cover in class with students.








