


Columbus County Schools: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006








Item 2 Responses: My child's teachers utilize class time in an effective manner.




Item 8 Responses: Alcohol use on campus is $\underline{\text{NOT}}$ widespread among students who attend this school.




Item 23 Responses: Students are provided challenging class work.






