




Hallsboro Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Expectations and School Climate</u> December 15, 2006



Hallsboro Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006




Hallsboro Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Effective Instruction</u> December 15, 2006




Percentage by Responses






Item 4 Responses: The principal knows what is going on in classes.


Item 8 Responses: Alcohol use on campus is <u>NOT</u> widespread among students who attend this school.







Item 20 Responses: Homework assignments consist of things that teachers cover in class with students.









Item 7 Responses: Bullying is <u>NOT</u> a problem at this school.
