




Old Dock Elementary School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006






Item 8 Responses: Alcohol use on campus is <u>NOT</u> widespread among students who attend this school.




Item 9 Responses: Tobacco use on campus is <u>NOT</u> widespread among students who attend this school.




Item 20 Responses: Homework assignments consist of things that teachers cover in class with students.



Item 22 Responses: Students are expected to do good work at this school.




Item 23 Responses: Students are provided challenging class work.






