




South Columbus High School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Expectations and School Climate</u> December 15, 2006




South Columbus High School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006






Item 6 Responses: Teachers at this school enjoy teaching.




Item 22 Responses: Students are expected to do good work at this school.




Item 23 Responses: Students are provided challenging class work.



Item 30 Responses: Graduation requirements have been distributed and explained to students, parents, and staff members.




Item 32 Responses: This school has provided opportunities to prepare students for the SAT, ACT, or PSAT.






