




Tabor City Elementary School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Expectations and School Climate</u> December 15, 2006




Tabor City Elementary School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006



Tabor City Elementary School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Effective Instruction</u> December 15, 2006






Item 8 Responses: Alcohol use on campus is <u>NOT</u> widespread among students who attend this school.




Item 9 Responses: Tobacco use on campus is $\underline{\text{NOT}}$ widespread among students who attend this school.



Item 10 Responses: Drug use on campus is <u>NOT</u> a serious problem among students who attend this school.


