






Percentage by Responses

Tabor City Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006




Tabor City Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Parent Survey Results <u>Effective Instruction</u> December 15, 2006




Percentage by Responses






Item 3 Responses: Adults treat students with respect in this school.


