




Cerro Gordo Elementary School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Staff Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006






Item 1 Responses: Students Feel Safe at this School




Item 5 Responses: All staff members care about what happens to the students.




Item 8 Responses: Alcohol use on campus is $\underline{\text{NOT}}$ widespread among students who attend this school.



Item 12 Responses: All students have an equal opportunity to participate in activities (clubs, musical groups, athletics, etc.).




Item 18 Responses: In classes, students spend time using computers or other technology.
