


East Columbus High School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Staff Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006








Item 12 Responses: All students have an equal opportunity to participate in activities (clubs, musical groups, athletics, etc.).




Item 22 Responses: Students are expected to do good work at this school.



Item 28 Responses: Arts Education (Ex. Music, Drama, Art, etc.) is an important part of the curriculum.




Item 30 Responses: Graduation requirements have been distributed and explained to students, parents, and staff members.






