






Fair Bluff Elementary School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Staff Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006






Item 4 Responses: The principal knows what is going on in classes.




Item 5 Responses: All staff members care about what happens to the students.




Item 8 Responses: Alcohol use on campus is $\underline{\text{NOT}}$ widespread among students who attend this school.



Item 9 Responses: Tobacco use on campus is <u>NOT</u> widespread among students who attend this school.




