




South Columbus High School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Staff Survey Results <u>Expectations and School Climate</u> December 15, 2006




South Columbus High School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Staff Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006






Item 2 Responses: Teachers Utilize Classtime in an Effective Manner




Item 4 Responses: The principal knows what is going on in classes.




Item 22 Responses: Students are expected to do good work at this school.



Item 30 Responses: Graduation requirements have been distributed and explained to students, parents, and staff members.




Item 34 Responses: This school lets parents/guardians know how their child(ren) are doing on a regular basis.






Item 15 Responses: Students are taught strategies on how to avoid fights and arguments in school.
