




# Tabor City Middle School: SACS-CASI/School Improvement Staff Survey Results <u>Discipline</u> December 15, 2006






Item 3 Responses: Adults treat students with respect in this school.




Item 4 Responses: The principal knows what is going on in classes.




Item 8 Responses: Alcohol use on campus is  $\underline{\text{NOT}}$  widespread among students who attend this school.



Item 22 Responses: Students are expected to do good work at this school.




Item 34 Responses: This school lets parents/guardians know how their child(ren) are doing on a regular basis.






Item 13 Responses: Students are well behaved at this school.
